INSTRUCTIONS / INFORMATION

WHEN YOU RECEIVE YOUR PLANTS

- If plants arrive damaged, **call or email us within 48 hours** of arrival. Please send photos to the email above.
- Place plants **outside** in bright shade. **Do not keep inside.**
- Check the moisture level in each pot, water if dry.
- Plant outside within 2 – 3 days.
- Eco-peanuts – if your package contains packing peanuts, these are 100% vegetable starch, certified compostable. Place in your composter, green bin or dissolve in water.

PLANTING DIRECTIONS

- Read the plant information on our website for any special soil, sun, water or other requirements.
- Our plants are grown outdoors in our nursery and are meant to be planted outdoors.
- If planting in a container, use good quality planting mix found at independent retail nurseries
- Keep young plants moist, not soaking, while getting established, do not allow them to dry out.
- After established, water according to their specific needs.
- Bait for snails and slugs. We use “Sluggo” an excellent, effective and non-toxic bait.
- Protect from deer, rabbits, birds and other critters.

EXTREME TEMPERATURE ADVISORY – Over 85° or Under 38°

Our plants are not guaranteed in extreme weather. If you are experiencing hot or cold weather in your area, please follow these guidelines to get your new plants off to a good start.

- Take your plants out of the box immediately and place them in a sheltered **outdoor** area.
If it's **HOT**, place plants in the shade and out of direct sun for a day or two, allowing them to acclimate to their new environment.
If it's **COLD**, place plants in a protected (warmer) outside area or cover them until cold weather passes.
- In heat, plant in the early morning or late afternoon. In cold, plant mid-day.
- If you do not plan to put your new plants in the ground within a week of receiving them, transplant them into a larger, at least one gallon, container with good drainage.
- Water your plants regularly and deeply to establish, preferably in the morning. All plants – even drought tolerant plants – need regular water to establish for the first 6 months.
